

Performer of the Month

Zara Davis, recently elevated to the top spot in the International Speed Windsurfing women's class ranking, first stepped on a windsurfer at 13 encouraged by her dad who was really keen. She stopped a couple of years later and didn't take it up again until she moved to Milton Keynes when she was 28 and joined Brogborough lake. Zara has been the women's overall winner at Weymouth Speed Week every year since 2004 except for 2007. Zara also holds the ladies Weymouth Harbour record at 32.44 knots which had stood for 22 years, set by the legendary Jenna De Rosnay. In 2008 she finished 2nd overall, her highest ranking ever. She's the Women's World Record holder for the mile at 34.74 knots and the Women's British Record Holder for 500m at 37.24 knots, She also enjoys skiing, snowboarding, yachting, swimming and Nordic walking and is sponsored by Simmer, Mistral, Spartan, Sonnetag Fins, DaKine, Maui Jim, Walnut Grove Clinic.
